

# Breast Pumps in Helena

The following is a list of what we consider the most effective electric breast pumps available for rent or purchase in Helena. There are several other brands available at the discount stores, but they tend to have poor suction or break down easily.

- WIC will supply electric breast pumps to women who are expressing milk for a hospitalized, premature, or disabled infant.
- DPHHS prefers that WIC electric pumps are distributed before Medicaid reimbursement is sought. Medicaid reimbursement for pumps is available for infants born before 37 weeks, infants who have feeding difficulties as a result of neurological impairment, and for infant and mothers who are separated as a result of an illness.
- WIC has manual breast pumps available for all mothers of infants over four weeks of age.
- WIC also has a limited number of double electric pumps for full time working mothers who plan to breastfeed for at least one year.
