Details: *No charge for vaccine
*Both injectable and nasal mist vaccine available
*Expect that there will be a wait for the vaccination

The amount of vaccine available is increasing week by week. As vaccine supply has increased, public health officials have expanded the population groups who have priority. Mike Henderson said, “The H1N1 vaccination will be easier to find in the next few weeks. We want to make it available to as many people in the priority groups as possible”.

The health department is distributing vaccine to medical practices and conducting free clinics to vaccinate people in the following groups:

For Whom:

- Pregnant women
- Household and caregiver contacts of infants less than 6 months of age
- People 6 months to 24 years
- People 25-64 years old with chronic medical conditions
- Health care and emergency medical services personnel
