H1N1 VACCINATION CLINIC SCHEDULE CHANGE
FOR WEEK OF NOVEMBER 2ND

Previously scheduled clinics:

- Radley School Gym, November 3rd, 3:30 – 7:00 pm: **CANCELED**
- Warren School Gym, November 5th, 3:30 – 6:30 pm: **CANCELED**

New schedule:

Where: Montana Department of Transportation, Auditorium
2701 Prospect Avenue, across from Walmart

When: Thursday, November 5, Noon – 6:00 pm

For Whom:

- *Pregnant Women
- *People who live with or care for children younger than 6 months of age
- *All children 6 months to 4 years of age
- *Children with chronic medical conditions under the age of 19 years
- *Health Care and Emergency Medical Services Personnel (with direct medical contact with patients or infectious materials)

Details:

- *No charge for vaccine
- *Both injectable and nasal mist vaccine available

Reason for Schedule Change:

A bigger venue for the flu clinics was needed to accommodate demand for the vaccine. The Department of Transportation Auditorium has plenty of parking and space for the numbers of people anticipated for the clinic. The Department of Transportation kindly offered their building to accommodate community need.

Other Information:

- Both Public Health Nurses and volunteers will be running the clinic.
- We have limited supplies of the vaccine, and are working to ensure that those most at risk for complications from the virus are protected.
- People should expect to wait for their immunization. We work to make the process as efficient as possible, but demand has created a waiting time for services.
